

# House Bill 3183

Sponsored by Representative GOMBERG

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Oregon Medical Board to conduct study on solar eclipse eye health. Requires report to committee of Legislative Assembly related to health care.

Sunsets January 2, 2018.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to solar eclipse eye health; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Oregon Medical Board shall conduct a study on solar eclipse eye health.**  
5 **The board shall ensure that at least one ophthalmologist contribute to the study. The board**  
6 **shall submit findings and recommendations for legislation to a committee of the Legislative**  
7 **Assembly related to health care not later than July 31, 2017.**

8 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2017 Act is repealed on January 2, 2018.**

9 **SECTION 3. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
10 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect**  
11 **on its passage.**
