## House Bill 3186

Sponsored by Representative RAYFIELD

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Makes strike or recognition of picket line of labor organization by assistant attorney general unlawful.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to assistant attorneys general; amending ORS 243.736. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. ORS 243.736 is amended to read: 4 243.736. (1) It is unlawful for any of the following public employees to strike or recognize a 5 6 picket line of a labor organization while in the performance of official duties: 7 (a) Assistant attorney general; 8 [(a)] **(b)** Deputy district attorneys; 9 [(b)] (c) Emergency communications worker; [(c)] (d) Employee of the Oregon Youth Authority who has custody, control or supervision of 10 youth offenders; 11 12 [(d)] (e) Firefighter; 13 [(e)] (f) Guard at a correctional institution or mental hospital; [(f)] (g) Parole and probation officer who supervises adult offenders; and 14 [(g)] (h) Police officer. 15 (2) As used in this section, "emergency communications worker" means an individual whose of-16 17 ficial focal duties are receiving information through the emergency communications system under ORS 403.105 to 403.250, relaying the information to public or private safety agencies or dispatching 18

emergency equipment or personnel in response to the information.
