House Bill 3196

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Directs Department of Human Services to study necessary improvements to regulation of community-based care, including but not limited to residential care facilities and adult foster homes, and report to appropriate committee or interim committee of Legislative Assembly. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to community-based care; and declaring an emergency. 2

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3

SECTION 1. The Department of Human Services shall study necessary improvements to 4

the regulation of community-based care, including but not limited to residential care facili-5

ties and adult foster homes. The department shall report on the results of the study to an 6

appropriate committee or interim committee of the Legislative Assembly no later than Sep-7

tember 1, 2018. 8

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2017 Act is repealed on January 2, 2019. 9

10 SECTION 3. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect 11 12 on its passage.
