House Bill 3201

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires that request or petition to district school board demonstrate that proposed change of service area of school meets certain requirements.

A BILL FOR AN ACT
Relating to service area of a school.
Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 330.
SECTION 2. (1) A request or petition to the district school board for a proposed change
to the service area of a school within a school district must demonstrate that the proposed
change incorporates the needs of the communities served by the school district, including
but not limited to:
(a) Proximity of schools to students' homes;
(b) Preservation of neighborhood unity;
(c) Student safety;
(d) Student transportation;
(e) Consistency with the city or county comprehensive plan, transportation plan and
public facility plan; and
(f) Consultation between the district school district and the governing body of the city
or the county regarding the proposed change.
(2) A demonstration by a school district under subsection (1)(e) or (f) of this section is
not a land use decision, as defined in ORS 197.015.
SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2017 Act applies to requests and petitions for proposed
changes to the service area of a school submitted on or after the effective date of this 2017
Act.
