6	Sec. 4. The Oregon Broadband Advisory Council shall submit a report by November 1 of each
7	even-numbered year to the Joint Legislative Committee on Information Management and Technology
8	on the following subjects:
9	(1) The affordability and accessibility of broadband technology in all areas of this state; [and]
10	(2) The extent of broadband technology use in this state in the telehealth industry, energy
11	management, education and government; and
12	(3) The role of broadband technology in local, state and regional economies and economic
