

House Bill 3216

Sponsored by Representative WHISNANT

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Chief Education Office to conduct study for purpose of identifying practices that assist students in poverty families. Directs office to submit report to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to education no later than September 15, 2018.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2017.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to students in poverty families; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Chief Education Office shall conduct a study for the purpose of**
5 **identifying practices that assist public school students in poverty families.**

6 **(2) Through the study, the office shall:**

7 **(a) Evaluate locally effective practices that improve the achievement outcomes of stu-**
8 **dents who are in poverty families;**

9 **(b) Identify any modifications that will improve the practices evaluated under paragraph**
10 **(a) of this subsection or that will make the practices more cost-efficient; and**

11 **(c) Identify sustainable funding sources for the practices evaluated under paragraph (a)**
12 **of this subsection.**

13 **(3) The office shall conduct the study in collaboration with stakeholders, including edu-**
14 **cators, school board members and school budget committee members.**

15 **(4) The office shall evaluate locally effective practices implemented by a variety of school**
16 **districts and shall take into account school district variations in size, location and other**
17 **demographics.**

18 **(5) The office shall conduct the study during the 2017-2018 school year and shall submit**
19 **a report to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to education no later**
20 **than September 15, 2018.**

21 **SECTION 2. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
22 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect**
23 **July 1, 2017.**
