

# House Bill 3219

Sponsored by Representatives NEARMAN, RESCHKE

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires public employer to publish collective bargaining agreement.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to public employer's publication of collective bargaining agreement.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 243.650 to 243.782.**

**SECTION 2. (1) A public employer shall publish a current collective bargaining agreement within 24 hours of executing the agreement, as follows:**

**(a) On the public employer's website;**

**(b) In a manner that is publicly accessible in the main office of the public employer; and**

**(c) On the Oregon transparency website.**

**(2) A collective bargaining agreement executed without the publication required under this section is voidable by any party to the agreement.**

**SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2017 Act applies to collective bargaining agreements entered into on or after the effective date of this 2017 Act.**
