House Bill 3254

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON HUMAN SERVICES AND HOUSING

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Directs Oregon Youth Authority to conduct statewide study regarding youth and youth offenders no later than July 1, 2018.

Requires authority to submit report regarding study to interim legislative committees no later than November 1, 2018.

Sunsets January 2, 2019.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to youth offenders; and declaring an emergency.
 - Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
 - SECTION 1. (1) No later than July 1, 2018, the Oregon Youth Authority shall conduct a statewide study regarding the status of youth and youth offenders in Oregon. The authority shall collaborate with the Department of Human Services in conducting the study under this subsection.
 - (2) No later than November 1, 2018, the authority shall submit a report to the interim legislative committees of the Legislative Assembly related to child welfare and juveniles regarding the study conducted in accordance with subsection (1) of this section.
 - SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2017 Act is repealed on January 2, 2019.
 - SECTION 3. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect on its passage.
