## House Bill 3282

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON JUDICIARY

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Removes psittacines not bred and maintained commercially from definition of "livestock" used for laws regarding offenses committed against animals, interference with livestock production, unlawful possession of iodine matrix and dogs chasing livestock.

2	Relating to livestock; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 609.125.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	<b>SECTION 1.</b> ORS 609.125 is amended to read:
5	609.125. As used in ORS 609.135 to 609.190, "livestock" means:
6	(1) Ratites, [psittacines,] horses, mules, jackasses, cattle, llamas, alpacas, sheep, goats, swine
7	domesticated fowl and any fur-bearing animal bred and maintained commercially or otherwise
8	within pens, cages and hutches; and
9	(2) Psittacines bred and maintained commercially.
10	SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 609.125 by section 1 of this 2017 Act apply to con
11	duct occurring on or after the effective date of this 2017 Act.
