SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Requires each public institution of higher education to submit [annual] report containing information about [noninstructional staff employed by] administrative positions and other cost drivers at institution to [Higher Education Coordinating Commission. Requires commission to compile reports and submit compiled report to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to education] Joint Committee on Ways and Means as part of institution's budget presentation during each regular session of Legislative Assembly held during odd-numbered year.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to noninstructional professional positions at public institutions of higher education.

3 Whereas the cost of higher education is increasingly expensive and has become an obstacle for

4 students seeking to obtain an education and achieve the American Dream; and

5 Whereas numerous credible studies have identified administrative services as a significant cost

6 driver at public institutions of higher education; and

7 Whereas public institutions of higher education pass on the cost of administrative positions by 8 raising tuition rates for students; now, therefore,

9 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

10 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) Each public institution of higher education as defined in ORS 350.350 shall

11 submit a report in the manner required under ORS 192.245 to the Joint Committee on Ways

12 and Means as part of the institution's budget presentation during each regular session of the

13 Legislative Assembly held during an odd-numbered year.

14 (2) Each report must be a concise narrative that identifies:
