SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Requires each public [institution of higher education] university to submit to Higher Education Coordinating Commission report [containing information about] identifying causes of increases in administrative positions and other cost drivers at [institution] university. Requires commission to compile reports and submit compiled report to Joint Committee on Ways and Means as part of [institution's] commission's budget presentation during each regular session of Legislative Assembly held during odd-numbered year.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to noninstructional professional positions at public institutions of higher education. $\mathbf{2}$ Whereas the cost of higher education is increasingly expensive and has become an obstacle for 3 students seeking to obtain an education and achieve the American Dream; and 4 Whereas numerous studies have identified administrative services as a significant cost driver 5 6 at public universities; and Whereas there are administrative cost drivers at public universities that result from legislative 7 8 mandates; and Whereas public universities bear increasing administrative costs that they cannot control and 9 that can lead to higher tuition rates for students; now, therefore, 10 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 11 12SECTION 1. (1) Not later than January 1 of each odd-numbered year, each public university listed in ORS 352.002 shall submit to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission 13 a report that is a concise narrative identifying: 14 (a) Legislative mandates imposed on public universities; 15(b) The impact of the legislative mandates on the costs of higher education at the public 16 17 university: (c) The causes of any increase in administrative positions occurring at the public uni-18 versity; 19 (d) The actions that have been taken at the public university to monitor and control cost 20drivers, such as administrative services; and 2122(e) Any other relevant matter the public university considers important to include in the 23report.

(2) The Higher Education Coordinating Commission shall compile a report from the re ports received by the commission pursuant to subsection (1) of this section and submit the

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- 1 compiled report in the manner required under ORS 192.245 to the Joint Committee on Ways
- 2 and Means as part of the commission's budget presentation during each regular session of
- 3 the Legislative Assembly held during an odd-numbered year.
- 4 <u>SECTION 2.</u> A public university shall submit the first report required under section 1 (1)
- 5 of this 2017 Act not later than January 1, 2019.

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
