

House Bill 3303

Sponsored by Representatives STARK, HACK, Senator GELSER; Representative PARRISH

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires hospital to have protocol to ensure that law enforcement agency is notified within seven days of collection of sexual assault forensic evidence kit and that kits are stored for no less than 60 days after collection.

2 Relating to forensic evidence.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 441.015 to**
5 **441.063.**

6 **SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section, "sexual assault forensic evidence kit" has the**
7 **meaning given that term in section 2, chapter 89, Oregon Laws 2016.**

8 **(2) A hospital must have a protocol that ensures:**

9 **(a) Compliance with section 5, chapter 89, Oregon Laws 2016; and**

10 **(b) That sexual assault forensic evidence kits are properly stored for at least 60 days af-**
11 **ter collection.**

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NOTE: Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.
