HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3352

1	On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after the first semicolon delete the rest of the line and line
2	3 and insert "and declaring an emergency.".
3	Delete lines 5 through 26 and delete pages 2 through 6 and insert:
4	"SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Health Authority in collaboration with the Department of
5	Education shall conduct an evaluation related to behavioral health services provided to public
6	school students in kindergarten through grade 12 in this state. The evaluation shall identify:
7	"(a) The current level of behavioral health services being provided, including:
8	"(A) Barriers and challenges to providing behavioral health services; and
9	"(B) Gaps in behavioral health services that are being provided and resources that are
10	available for behavioral health services.
11	"(b) How information collected under paragraph (a) of this subsection shall be incorpo-
12	rated into five-year plans of coordinated care organizations, including how the information
13	will be used to:
14	"(A) Develop common measurements of success and best practices for the purposes of
15	achieving, at a minimum, the following:
16	"(i) An increase in mental health referrals and treatments between schools and
17	community-based behavioral health professionals;
18	"(ii) A decrease in expulsions for students with behavioral health needs; and
19	"(iii) A decrease in chronic absenteeism for students with behavioral health needs.
20	"(B) Develop a local system of behavioral health services that is based on a shared set
21	of principles, common measurements of success and best practices for providing direct
22	classroom support for students and teachers to ensure the highest opportunity of educa-
23	tional success for students with behavioral health needs.
24	"(C) Increase the collaboration between coordinated care organizations and school dis-
25	tricts.
26	"(2) For the purpose of collecting information and identifying data elements and meth-
27	odology, the authority shall collaborate with representatives of:
28	"(a) A state-based association that represents school administrators; and
29	"(b) State-based coordinated care organizations.
30	"(3) The authority shall submit a report on the evaluation described in subsections (1)
31	and (2) of this section to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to ed-
32	ucation or health care no later than December 30, 2017.

"SECTION 2. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public

peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect

on its passage.".
