

House Bill 3416

Sponsored by Representative BYNUM, Senator THOMSEN

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Transportation to offer extended weekday hours and Saturday operating schedules at field offices.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the hours of operation of the Department of Transportation's field offices.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, "field office" means a branch office operated by**
5 **the Department of Transportation where applications for driver licenses or motor vehicle**
6 **registrations are accepted.**

7 **(2)(a) The department shall establish extended hours on weekdays and Saturday operating**
8 **schedules for field offices. Different field offices may offer extended hours on different**
9 **weekdays.**

10 **(b) At a minimum, field offices shall be open to the public:**

11 **(A) Between the hours of 5 p.m. and 8 p.m. on one weekday, Monday through Friday; and**

12 **(B) For four hours on Saturday.**

13 **(3) Subsection (2) of this section does not apply to legal holidays specified in ORS 187.010**
14 **or 187.020.**
