

House Bill 3434

Sponsored by Representatives ESQUIVEL, LININGER, Senator ROBLAN; Representative REARDON

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Extends sunset date for public safety fiscal emergency program for counties.
Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to public safety fiscal emergencies; amending sections 13 and 14, chapter 753, Oregon Laws
3 2013; and prescribing an effective date.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 14, chapter 753, Oregon Laws 2013, is amended to read:

6 **Sec. 14.** Sections 1 to 10 [*of this 2013 Act*], **chapter 753, Oregon Laws 2013**, are repealed on
7 January 2, [2018] **2024**.

8 **SECTION 2.** Section 13, chapter 753, Oregon Laws 2013, is amended to read:

9 **Sec. 13.** The amendments to ORS 203.055 by section 12 [*of this 2013 Act*], **chapter 753, Oregon**
10 **Laws 2013**, become operative on January 2, [2018] **2024**.

11 **SECTION 3.** **This 2017 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2017**
12 **regular session of the Seventy-ninth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.**
