

House Bill 3438

Sponsored by Representatives SANCHEZ, WILLIAMSON

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to study reentry services and support and report results to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to judiciary on or before September 15, 2018.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to reentry after incarceration.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Oregon Criminal Justice Commission shall study the services and sup-**
5 **port available to offenders released into the community after incarceration, including pro-**
6 **grams that facilitate or provide housing and the ability to access treatment in counties other**
7 **than the county of release. The commission shall submit a report detailing the results of the**
8 **study to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary in the**
9 **manner provided by ORS 192.245 no later than September 15, 2018.**
