SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Creates crime of unlawful possession of prohibited container on public beach. Punishes by maximum of 30 days' imprisonment, \$1,250 fine, or both.
