House Bill 3460

Sponsored by Representative BUEHLER, Senator STEINER HAYWARD

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Oregon Health Authority to establish firearm safety and suicide prevention education program consisting of creation or approval of specified educational materials and provision of materials to gun dealers.

Provides that gun dealers may make educational materials available to firearm purchasers.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to firearm educational materials.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Oregon Health Authority shall by rule establish a firearm safety and 5 suicide prevention education program. The program shall consist solely of:

6 (a) The creation or approval, in consultation with firearm rights groups, of firearm safety

7 and suicide prevention educational materials. Multiple versions of the materials must be

8 created or approved to reflect the different local values and cultures within this state.

9 (b) The distribution to all gun dealers operating within this state, free of charge, of the 10 educational materials described in paragraph (a) of this subsection.

(2)(a) A gun dealer may make available to a purchaser, free of charge, in a prominent
location near the point of sale in the gun dealer's place of business, the educational materials
described in subsection (1) of this section.

14 (b) Prior to a firearm transfer, a gun dealer may ensure that a purchaser is made aware

15 of the availability of the educational materials described in subsection (1) of this section.

16 (3) As used in this section:

17 (a) "Firearm" has the meaning given that term in ORS 166.210.

18 (b) "Gun dealer" and "purchaser" have the meanings given those terms in ORS 166.412.
