

# House Bill 5007

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Presession filed (at the request of Oregon Department of Administrative Services)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

- Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Employment Department for Oregon Talent Council.
- Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and certain federal funds, but excluding lottery funds and other federal funds, collected or received by Employment Department.
- Appropriates moneys from certain federal funds to department for certain purposes.
- Appropriates moneys from Employment Department Special Administrative Fund for certain purposes.
- Limits biennial expenditures by department from other federal funds.
- Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures.
- Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2017.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the financial administration of the Employment Department; and declaring an emer-  
3 gency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the Employment Department, for the biennium**  
6 **beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$159,235 for the Oregon Talent**  
7 **Council.**

8 **SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts**  
9 **are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limits for payment**  
10 **of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and**  
11 **moneys appropriated to the Employment Department by sections 3 and 4 of this 2017 Act,**  
12 **but excluding lottery funds and federal funds other than those described in section 3 of this**  
13 **2017 Act, collected or received by the Employment Department:**

- 14 (1) **Unemployment insurance,**
- 15 **business and workforce**
- 16 **development, and workforce**
- 17 **and economic research ..... \$119,097,667**
- 18 (2) **Office of Administrative**
- 19 **Hearings..... \$ 27,961,329**
- 20 (3) **Capital improvement..... \$ 765,500**

21 **SECTION 3. (1) There is appropriated to the Employment Department, for the biennium**  
22 **beginning July 1, 2017, out of the funds made available to the state on March 13, 2002, under**  
23 **section 903(d) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1103(d)), as amended, the amount of**  
24 **\$6,000,000 to be used under the direction of the Employment Department for the purposes**  
25 **of administering unemployment compensation law and public employment offices and for**  
26 **debt service and capital improvements.**

1       **(2) There is appropriated to the Employment Department, for the biennium beginning**  
2 **July 1, 2017, out of the modernization funds made available to the state on June 4, 2009, and**  
3 **July 16, 2009, under section 903(f) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1103(f)), as amended,**  
4 **the amount of \$6,603,602 to be used under the direction of the Employment Department for**  
5 **the purposes of administering unemployment compensation law and public employment of-**  
6 **fices and for debt service and capital improvements.**

7       **(3) Expenditures of funds appropriated to the Employment Department under this section**  
8 **are limited by section 2 (1) and (3) of this 2017 Act.**

9       **SECTION 4. (1) There is appropriated to the Employment Department, for the biennium**  
10 **beginning July 1, 2017, out of the Employment Department Special Administrative Fund es-**  
11 **tablished in ORS 657.822, the amount of \$20,000,000 to be used under the direction of the**  
12 **Employment Department for the purposes of administering unemployment compensation law**  
13 **and public employment offices and for debt service and capital improvements.**

14       **(2) Expenditures of funds appropriated to the Employment Department under this section**  
15 **are limited by section 2 (1) and (3) of this 2017 Act.**

16       **SECTION 5. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**  
17 **\$160,349,059 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limit for**  
18 **payment of expenses from federal funds other than those described in section 3 of this 2017**  
19 **Act collected or received by the Employment Department.**

20       **SECTION 6. (1) For the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, expenditures by the Employment**  
21 **Department for unemployment insurance claims from the Unemployment Compensation**  
22 **Trust Fund are not limited.**

23       **(2) For the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, expenditures by the Employment Department**  
24 **for benefits paid under the federal Trade Act and for unemployment insurance claims from**  
25 **federal funds are not limited.**

26       **SECTION 7. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
27 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect**  
28 **July 1, 2017.**
