## House Bill 5009

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Presession filed (at the request of Oregon Department of Administrative Services)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by State Department of Energy.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from lottery moneys. Limits biennial expenditures by department from federal funds. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2017.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the financial administration of the State Department of Energy; and declaring an emer-3 gency.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 6 \$35,318,204 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limit for 7 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, 8 but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the State Department 9 of Energy. 10 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of

\$3,023,630 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to the State Department of Energy for debt service for the energy efficiency and sustainable technology loan program, and for the Public Schools Grant Program.

16 <u>SECTION 3.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 17 \$2,475,582 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limit for 18 payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the State Department of 19 Energy.

20 <u>SECTION 4.</u> This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 21 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect 22 July 1, 2017.
