

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5017

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 27 and delete page 2 and insert:

2 “**SECTION 1.** There are appropriated to the Legislative Administration Committee, for
3 the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for
4 payment of the expenses of the Legislative Administration Committee, for the following
5 purposes:

6 (1) General program..... \$ 24,336,204

7 (2) Debt service \$ 12,873,776

8 “**SECTION 2.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts
9 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limits for payment
10 of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-
11 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative Adminis-
12 tration Committee:

13 (1) General program..... \$ 2,453,495

14 (2) Debt service \$ 1,192,375

15 “**SECTION 3.** For the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, expenditures by the Legislative
16 Administration Committee from the Stores Revolving Account and the Property and Supplies
17 Stores Account established in ORS 173.790 are not limited.

18 “**SECTION 4.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
19 \$300,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limit for
20 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,
21 but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative Ad-
22 ministration Committee, for expenses related to the Oregon Capitol History Gateway from
23 the Oregon Capitol History Gateway Fund.

24 “**SECTION 5.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$25,000
25 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limit for payment of
26 expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-
27 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative Adminis-
28 tration Committee, for expenses related to operations for the Oregon State Capitol
29 Foundation from the Oregon State Capitol Foundation Operating Fund.

30 “**SECTION 6.** There is appropriated to the Legislative Assembly, for the biennium begin-
31 ning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$14,345,214 for payment of the ex-
32 penses of the following offices:

33 “(1) The offices of the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Repre-
34 sentatives;

35 “(2) The majority and minority offices of the Senate and of the House of Representatives;

1 and

2 “(3) The offices of the Secretary of the Senate and the Chief Clerk of the House of Rep-
3 resentatives.

4 “SECTION 7. (1) There is appropriated to the Legislative Assembly, for the biennium
5 beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$18,041,769 for payment of the
6 expenses of members of the Seventy-ninth Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon.

7 “(2) There is appropriated to the Legislative Assembly, for the biennium beginning July
8 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$9,305,980 for payment of the expenses of
9 members of the Eightieth Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon.

10 “SECTION 8. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$26,570
11 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limit for payment of
12 expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-
13 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative Assembly.

14 “SECTION 9. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, expenditures by the Legislative
15 Assembly from the Lounge Revolving Account established in ORS 171.117, for the costs of
16 food served in members’ lounges and reimbursed through receipts on the basis of sales or
17 by payroll deductions from members, are not limited.

18 “SECTION 10. There is appropriated to the Legislative Counsel Committee, for the
19 biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$12,785,719.

20 “SECTION 11. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of
21 \$1,638,291 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limit for
22 payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,
23 but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative Counsel
24 Committee.

25 “SECTION 12. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, expenditures by the Legislative
26 Counsel Committee from the ORS Revolving Account established in ORS 171.305 and from
27 the Legislative Publications Account established in ORS 171.245, for services and supplies
28 connected with printing and distributing legislative publications and the Oregon Revised
29 Statutes, are not limited.

30 “SECTION 13. (1) There is appropriated to the Legislative Fiscal Officer, for the biennium
31 beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$4,301,378.

32 “(2) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$3,779,805 is es-
33 tablished for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limit for payment of ex-
34 penses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding
35 lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Legislative Fiscal Officer.

36 “SECTION 14. There is appropriated to the Legislative Policy and Research Committee,
37 for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$8,892,462.

38 “SECTION 15. There is appropriated to the Legislative Revenue Officer, for the biennium
39 beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$3,036,432.

40 “SECTION 16. There is appropriated to the Commission on Indian Services, for the
41 biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$539,068.

42 “SECTION 17. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$7,035
43 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limit for payment of
44 expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-
45 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Commission on Indian

1 **Services.**

2 **“SECTION 18. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
3 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect**
4 **July 1, 2017.”**
