SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Long Term Care Ombudsman for biennial expenses. Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and federal Older Americans Act funds received from Department of Human Services, but excluding lottery funds and other federal funds, collected or received by Long Term Care Ombudsman.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Emergency Board for allocation to Long Term Care Ombudsman for costs associated with public guardian and conservator program. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2017.

5	SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Long Term Care Ombudsman, for the
6	biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the following amounts for the fol-

13	SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$896,835
14	is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limit for payment of
15	expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, and in-
16	cluding federal Older Americans Act funds received from the Department of Human Services,
17	but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in this section, collected or re-
18	ceived by the Long Term Care Ombudsman.
19	SECTION 3. (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
20	priated to the Emergency Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General
21	Fund, the amount of \$200,000, to be allocated to the Long Term Care Ombudsman for costs
22	associated with the public guardian and conservator program.
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(2) If any of the moneys appropriated by subsection (1) of this section are not allocated
by the Emergency Board prior to December 1, 2018, the moneys remaining on that date be-

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1 come available for any purpose for which the Emergency Board lawfully may allocate funds.

2 <u>SECTION 4.</u> This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public

peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect
July 1, 2017.

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
