

# A-Engrossed House Bill 5025

Ordered by the House June 29  
Including House Amendments dated June 29

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of Oregon Department of Administrative Services)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Business Development Department for biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by department for certain purposes.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from lottery moneys for certain purposes.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from federal funds for certain purposes.

Authorizes certain nonlimited expenditures.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2017.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to the financial administration of the Oregon Business Development Department; and declaring an emergency.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Oregon Business Development Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for the following purposes:**

(1) Oregon Arts Commission..... \$ 3,766,602

(2) Business, innovation and trade..... \$ 3,556,629

(3) Debt service ..... \$ 40,625,560

**SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Business Development Department, for the following purposes:**

(1) Business, innovation and trade..... \$ 11,911,165

(2) Infrastructure Finance Authority..... \$203,001,120

(3) Operations..... \$ 1,912,085

(4) Arts and Cultural Trust ..... \$ 10,418,444

**SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts**

12 **SECTION 4.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts  
13 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limits for payment  
14 of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Oregon Business Development  
15 Department, for the following purposes:

- 16 (1) Business, innovation  
17 and trade..... \$ 4,861,653
- 18 (2) Infrastructure Finance  
19 Authority ..... \$ 33,708,202
- 20 (3) Operations..... \$ 199,620
- 21 (4) Arts..... \$ 1,961,360

22 **SECTION 5.** For the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, expenditures by the Oregon Busi-  
23 ness Development Department are not limited for:

24 (1) Loans from the following funds:

25 (a) Oregon Business Development Fund (ORS 285B.092), Oregon Entrepreneurial Devel-  
26 opment Loan Fund (ORS 285B.758), Credit Enhancement Fund (ORS 285B.215) and  
27 Brownfields Redevelopment Fund (ORS 285A.188).

28 (b) Special Public Works Fund (ORS 285B.455), Water Fund (ORS 285B.563), Marine  
29 Navigation Improvement Fund (ORS 777.267), Oregon Port Revolving Fund (ORS 285A.708)  
30 and Safe Drinking Water Revolving Loan Fund (ORS 285A.213).

31 (2) Debt service, excluding debt service on lottery revenue bonds and general obligation  
32 bonds.

33 **SECTION 6.** This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
34 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect  
35 July 1, 2017.
