## A BILL FOR AN ACT Relating to the financial administration of the Oregon Health Authority; and declaring an emergency. Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), the 6 following new or increased fees, adopted by the Oregon Health Authority and approved by the 7 Oregon Department of Administrative Services, are approved:
