CHAPTER

AN ACT

Relating to the financial administration of the Oregon Health Authority; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. For the purpose of carrying out the provisions of ORS 291.055 (1)(e), the following new or increased fees, adopted by the Oregon Health Authority and approved by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services, are approved:

 - (g) **Basic Field of Testing, Out of State, First Program..... \$ 120**
 - (h) **Basic Field of Testing, Out of State, Each Additional Program..... \$ 13**
 - (i) **Moderate Field of Testing, Out of State, First Program..... \$ 462**
 - (j) **Moderate Field of Testing, Out of State, Each Additional Program..... \$ 53**
 - (k) **Complex Field of Testing, Out of State, First Program..... \$ 660**
