

A-Engrossed House Bill 5031

Ordered by the House June 26

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of State Police for certain biennial expenses.

Limits certain biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by department.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from federal funds for certain purposes.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from certain moneys or other revenues allocated to Parks and Natural Resources Fund for certain purposes.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2017.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Department of State Police, for the biennium**
6 **beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for the following**
7 **purposes:**

8 (1) **Patrol services, criminal**
9 **investigations and gaming**
10 **enforcement..... \$ 155,424,123**

11 (2) **Fish and wildlife enforcement... \$ 9,425,292**

12 (3) **Forensic services and**
13 **State Medical Examiner..... \$ 48,007,227**

14 (4) **Administrative services,**
15 **agency support, criminal**
16 **justice information services**
17 **and office of the State Fire**
18 **Marshal..... \$ 57,964,296**

19 (5) **Debt service..... \$ 358,283**

20 **SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts**
21 **are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limits for payment**
22 **of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-**
23 **cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Department of State**
24 **Police, for the following purposes:**

26 **SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
 27 **\$8,309,518 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limit for**
 28 **payment of expenses from moneys allocated from the Parks and Natural Resources Fund to**
 29 **the Department of State Police for fish and wildlife enforcement activities.**

30 **SECTION 5. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
 31 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect**
 32 **July 1, 2017.**

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
