SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Public Defense Services Commission for certain biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by commission.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2017.

Relating to the financial administration of the Public Defense Services Commission; and declaring

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> There are appropriated to the Public Defense Services Commission, for the

biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for the
following purposes:

(1) Appellate Division \$ 20,589,175

(2) **Professional services...... \$352,695,436**

10 (3) Contract and Business

Services Division...... \$ 6,188,215

12 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts 13 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limits for payment 14 of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-15 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Public Defense Services 16 Commission, for the following purposes:

17 (1) Professional services...... \$ 3,544,845

18 (2) Contract and Business

Services Division...... \$ 565,105

20 <u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 21 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect 22 July 1, 2017.
