SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure

Limits certain biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by Public Utility Commission of Oregon.

Limits biennial expenditures by commission from federal funds. Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2017.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 4

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts $\mathbf{5}$ are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limits for payment

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$721,958 16 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, as the maximum limit for payment of 17 expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Public Utility Commission of 18 Oregon. 19

SECTION 3. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, expenditures by the Public Utility 20Commission of Oregon from the universal service fund established in ORS 759.425 are not 21 limited. 22

23 SECTION 4. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect 24 July 1, 2017. 25
