**SUMMARY**

Declares emergency, effective *[July 1, 2017]* **on passage.**

**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

Relating to state financial administration; and declaring an emergency.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$23,850,000 is established for a six-year period beginning July 1, 2015, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and reimbursements from federal service agreements, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in this section, collected or received by the Higher Education Coordinating Commission, for expenditures of proceeds from state bonds issued for the benefit of a community college, pursuant to agreements between the commission and a community college.**

**SECTION 2. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect on its passage.**
