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11 <u>SECTION 2.</u> In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-12 ated to the State Forestry Department, for the Agency Administration division, for the 13 biennium ending June 30, 2017, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$1,689,072, for the 14 purpose of purchasing a catastrophic wildfire insurance policy for the 2017 fire season.

15 SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on 16 expenditures established by section 2 (1), chapter 809, Oregon Laws 2015, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous 17 18 Receipts and including federal funds from the United States Forest Service for fire protection 19 and for research projects, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in 20section 2, chapter 809, Oregon Laws 2015, collected or received by the State Forestry De-21partment, is increased by \$1,689,072 for the purpose of purchasing a catastrophic wildfire 22insurance policy for the 2017 fire season.

SECTION 4. Sections 67 and 68, chapter 82, Oregon Laws 2016, are repealed.

24 <u>SECTION 5.</u> This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 25 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect 26 on its passage.

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
