

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 5044

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, after the semicolon insert “creating new provisions; repealing  
2 sections 67 and 68, chapter 82, Oregon Laws 2016;”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 15 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law appropriating money, limiting expenditures  
5 or otherwise adjusting appropriations or expenditure limitations, and in addition to any  
6 action by the Emergency Board, the authorized appropriations for the biennium ending June  
7 30, 2017, for the following agencies and programs are changed by the amounts specified:**

32 **“SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-  
33 priated to the State Forestry Department, for the Agency Administration division, for the  
34 biennium ending June 30, 2017, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$1,689,072, for the  
35 purpose of purchasing a catastrophic wildfire insurance policy for the 2017 fire season.**

1       **“SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limitation on**  
2 **expenditures established by section 2 (1), chapter 809, Oregon Laws 2015, as the maximum**  
3 **limit for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous**  
4 **Receipts and including federal funds from the United States Forest Service for fire protection**  
5 **and for research projects, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in**  
6 **section 2, chapter 809, Oregon Laws 2015, collected or received by the State Forestry De-**  
7 **partment, is increased by \$1,689,072 for the purpose of purchasing a catastrophic wildfire**  
8 **insurance policy for the 2017 fire season.**

9       **“SECTION 4. Sections 67 and 68, chapter 82, Oregon Laws 2016, are repealed.**

10       **“SECTION 5. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
11 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect**  
12 **on its passage.”.**
