House Concurrent Resolution 15

Sponsored by Representatives KENNEMER, OLSON, Senator OLSEN (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Recognizes and honors Oregon State Police Trooper William Thomas Levinson (1925-1950) for his service to this state.

2	Whereas Oregon State Police Trooper William Thomas Levinson was born on February 1, 1925
3	in Syracuse, Indiana, to William and Ruby Levinson and had one sister; and
4	Whereas Trooper Levinson left high school in July 1942 to enlist in the United States Navy
5	where he received a Purple Heart and three Bronze Stars while serving his country; and
6	Whereas in 1945 Trooper Levinson married Neva Severy, with whom he had a daughter
7	Patricia, and a son, Rod William; and
8	Whereas Trooper Levinson was honorably discharged from the military in March 1949 and
9	joined the Oregon State Police in May of that year, serving first in Florence and later in Salem; and
10	Whereas on September 7, 1950, upon learning of a daily report that needed to be delivered
11	Trooper Levinson volunteered to transport it by motorcycle; and
12	Whereas while stopped near a railroad crossing, Trooper Levinson's motorcycle engaged into
13	gear and collided with a passing train; and
14	Whereas Trooper Levinson was thrown beneath the train and died immediately; and
15	Whereas Trooper Levinson was survived by his parents, his wife and his four-year-old daughter
16	and nine-month-old son; and
17	Whereas Trooper Levinson enjoyed motorcycles, reading, helping people and spending time with
18	his family and neighborhood children; and
19	Whereas Trooper Levinson did an important job and did it with passion, dedication and dili
20	gence; and
21	Whereas Trooper Levinson's loss was deeply felt by his family, his fellow officers and his many
22	friends; now, therefore,
23	Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:
24	That we, the members of the Seventy-ninth Legislative Assembly, recognize and honor Trooper
25	William Thomas Levinson for his service to this state.
