## CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 1 2 Whereas National Speech and Debate Education Day is being celebrated on March 3, 2017; and 3 Whereas established by the National Speech and Debate Association, in conjunction with na-4 tional and local partners, this occasion serves to promote better instruction in speech and debate 5 across all grade levels and to highlight the pivotal roles these abilities play in personal advocacy, social movements and public policy making; and 6 7 Whereas speech and debate involvement leads to increased positive civic education and civic 8 engagement for our young people; and 9 Whereas speech and debate education helps students develop important skills in communication, 10 critical thinking, creativity and collaboration through the practice of public speaking; and 11 Whereas participants learn not only to analyze and express complex ideas effectively but also 12 to listen and concur; and 13 Whereas participants also learn questioning techniques and how to dissent with reason and compassion; and 14 15 Whereas across the country, countless educators devote in-school, after-school and weekend time to supporting their students in speech and debate practices and competitions, and the example of 16 17 hard work and dedication they set has a lasting, positive impact on their pupils; and 18 Whereas the skills learned through speech and debate education serve students well throughout 19 their lives, and National Speech and Debate Education Day presents a welcome opportunity to recognize such instruction as an essential component of a well-rounded curriculum; now, therefore, 20 Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon: 21 22 That we, the members of the Seventy-ninth Legislative Assembly, recognize March 3, 2017, as
