## **House Joint Resolution 26**

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution to prohibit law creating, repealing or modifying tax credit from containing provisions on any other subject or from modifying more than one tax credit. Refers proposed amendment to people for their approval or rejection at next regular general election.

1	JOINT RESOLUTION
2	Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:
3	PARAGRAPH 1. The Constitution of the State of Oregon is amended by creating a new section
4	16 to be added to and made a part of Article IX, such section to read:
5	SECTION 16. A law creating, repealing or modifying a tax credit may not contain pro-
6	visions on any other subject and may not contain changes to more than one tax credit.

8	PARAGRAPH 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be submitted to the
9	people for their approval or rejection at the next regular general election held throughout
10	this state.
