## **House Joint Resolution 5**

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Presession filed (at the request of Secretary of State Jeanne P. Atkins)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Proposes amendment to Oregon Constitution to permit Legislative Assembly, or people through initiative process, to enact laws limiting or prohibiting contributions made in connection with campaigns for nomination or election to public office.

Refers proposed amendment to people for their approval or rejection at next regular general election.

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## JOINT RESOLUTION

Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon: 2

PARAGRAPH 1. Section 8, Article II of the Constitution of the State of Oregon, is amended to 3 read:

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5 Sec. 8. (1) The Legislative Assembly shall enact laws to support the privilege of free suffrage, prescribing the manner of regulating[,] and conducting elections[,] and prohibiting under adequate 6 7 penalties[,] all undue influence therein[,] from power, bribery, tumult[,] and other improper conduct. 8 [-]

(2) The Legislative Assembly, or the people through the initiative process, may enact 9 laws limiting or prohibiting contributions made in connection with campaigns for nomination 10 or election to public office. This subsection applies to laws enacted by the Legislative As-11 12 sembly, or enacted or approved by the people through the initiative process, on or after the effective date of the amendment to this section by House Joint Resolution 5 (2017). 13

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PARAGRAPH 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be submitted to the 15people for their approval or rejection at the next regular general election held throughout 16 this state. 17

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
