¹ "<u>SECTION 4.</u> The transfer of duties, functions and powers to the Housing and Community Services Department by section 1 of this 2017 Act does not affect any action, proceeding or prosecution involving or with respect to the duties, functions and powers begun before and pending at the time of the transfer, except that the Housing and Community Services Department is substituted for the State Department of Energy in the action, proceeding or prosecution.

"(Liability, Duty, Obligation)

10 "<u>SECTION 5.</u> (1) Nothing in sections 1 to 7 of this 2017 Act relieves a person of a liability, 11 duty or obligation accruing under or with respect to the duties, functions and powers 12 transferred by section 1 of this 2017 Act. The Housing and Community Services Department 13 may undertake the collection or enforcement of any such liability, duty or obligation.

"(2) The rights and obligations of the State Department of Energy legally incurred under contracts, leases and business transactions executed, entered into or begun before the operative date of section 1 of this 2017 Act accruing under or with respect to the duties, functions and powers transferred by section 1 of this 2017 Act are transferred to the Housing and Community Services Department. For the purpose of succession to these rights and obligations, the Housing and Community Services Department is a continuation of the State Department of Energy and not a new authority.

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"(Rules)

"SECTION 6. Notwithstanding the transfer of duties, functions and powers by section 1 24 25of this 2017 Act, the rules of the State Department of Energy with respect to such duties, 26functions or powers that are in effect on the operative date of section 1 of this 2017 Act 27continue in effect until superseded or repealed by rules of the Housing and Community Services Department. References in the rules of the State Department of Energy to the State 28 29 Department of Energy or an officer or employee of the State Department of Energy are considered to be references to the Housing and Community Services Department or an offi-30 cer or employee of the Housing and Community Services Department. 31

"SECTION 7. Whenever, in any uncodified law or resolution of the Legislative Assembly 3233 or in any rule, document, record or proceeding authorized by the Legislative Assembly, in the context of the duties, functions and powers transferred by section 1 of this 2017 Act, 34reference is made to the State Department of Energy, or an officer or employee of the State 35 Department of Energy, whose duties, functions or powers are transferred by section 1 of this 36 2017 Act, the reference is considered to be a reference to the Housing and Community Ser-37 38 vices Department or an officer or employee of the Housing and Community Services Department who by this 2017 Act is charged with carrying out the duties, functions and powers. 39 40
