

Senate Bill 1004

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON EDUCATION

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Allows governing body of county to dedicate portion of moneys transferred to county school fund from federal forest reserve receipts if certain conditions are met.

2 Relating to use of federal forest reserve receipts transferred to county school funds; amending ORS
3 328.005.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 328.005 is amended to read:

6 328.005. (1) The governing body of each county shall create a county school fund.

7 **(2) Notwithstanding ORS 294.060 (1), when the governing body of a county transfers fed-**
8 **eral forest reserve receipts to a county school fund as provided by ORS 294.060 (1), the gov-**
9 **erning body may dedicate a portion of the moneys to career and technical training provided**
10 **through the public schools of the county or for the benefit of students at the public schools**
11 **of the county if:**

12 **(a) The moneys will be used to leverage other state or federal moneys for career and**
13 **technical training, including grants for career and technical education or grants that connect**
14 **students with their communities;**

15 **(b) The moneys will be used to prepare students for careers that involve value-added**
16 **wood products manufacturing or construction;**

17 **(c) Data will be collected to determine student outcomes based on use of the moneys;**

18 **(d) The amount of moneys dedicated under this subsection does not exceed \$500,000 an-**
19 **nually;**

20 **(e) The use of the moneys is consistent with the duties of the local workforce investment**
21 **board under ORS 660.327 or with the county economic development plan under ORS 280.500;**
22 **and**

23 **(f) The county is located in the geographic region identified under ORS 284.592.**

24 [(2)] **(3)** When a county governing body transfers federal forest reserve receipts under ORS
25 294.060 (4) subject to a condition that such moneys be used only for a purpose described in ORS
26 328.205 (1)(a) or (c), a school district receiving a share of [*such*] **the** moneys may not use the moneys
27 for any other purpose.
