

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 101

1 Delete lines 4 through 20 of the printed bill and insert:

2 “**SECTION 1.** ORS 419B.045 is amended to read:

3 “419B.045. If an investigation of a report of child abuse is conducted on [*public*] school premises,  
4 the school administrator shall first be notified that the investigation is to take place, unless the  
5 school administrator is a subject of the investigation. **The Department of Human Services or the**  
6 **law enforcement agency conducting the investigation is not required to reveal information**  
7 **about the investigation to the school as a condition of conducting the investigation.** The  
8 school administrator or a school staff member designated by the administrator may, at the  
9 investigator’s discretion, be present to facilitate the investigation. The [*Department of Human Ser-*  
10 *vices or the law enforcement agency making the investigation*] **investigator** shall be advised **by a**  
11 **school administrator or a school staff member** of [*the*] a child’s disabling conditions, if any, prior  
12 to any interview with the [*affected*] child. A school administrator or **school** staff member [*is not*  
13 *authorized to reveal anything that transpires*] **shall not notify any person other than the depart-**  
14 **ment or law enforcement agency of an investigation described in this section and may not**  
15 **disclose any information obtained** during an investigation [*in which the administrator or staff*  
16 *member participates*], nor shall the information become part of the child’s school records. The school  
17 administrator or **school** staff member may testify at any subsequent [*trial*] **court proceeding** re-  
18 sulting from the investigation and may be interviewed by the respective litigants prior to any such  
19 [*trial*] **court proceeding.”.**
