Senate Bill 1013

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Requires Secretary of State, in consultation with Director of Department of Revenue, to conduct study and develop recommendations regarding desirability and most effective method for using tax filings submitted to Department of Revenue to ensure accuracy of addresses of electors contained in centralized voter registration system.

Requires secretary to submit report detailing recommendations by September 15, 2018. Sunsets January 2, 2019.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to voter registration.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. (1) The Secretary of State, in consultation with the Director of the Department of Revenue, shall conduct a study and develop recommendations regarding the desirability and most effective method for using tax filings submitted to the Department of Revenue to ensure the accuracy of the addresses of electors contained in the centralized voter registration system. The study may include recommendations for additional legislation.

(2) The secretary shall submit a report in the manner provided in ORS 192.245, including detailing the recommendations made under subsection (1) of this section, to the interim legislative committees on rules no later than September 15, 2018.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2017 Act is repealed on January 2, 2019.
