SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

[Directs Department of Veterans' Affairs to conduct statewide study regarding veteran-owned small businesses no later than July 1, 2018.]

[Requires department to submit report regarding study to interim legislative committees no later than November 1, 2018.] [Sunsets January 2, 2019.]

Appropriates moneys to Oregon Military Department for Oregon Military Museum. Declares emergency, effective [on passage] July 1, 2017.

2	Relating to veterans; and declaring an emergency.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the Oregon Military Department, for the biennium
5	beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$3,500,000 for:
6	(1) Creation of exhibits at the Oregon Military Museum; and
7	(2) Capital expenditures directly related to the establishment and maintenance of the
8	museum.
9	SECTION 2. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
10	peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect

11 July 1, 2017.
