

Senate Bill 1030

Sponsored by Senator THOMSEN

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Clarifies that moneys available for Ballot Measure 98 (2016) are to be in addition to moneys available through State School Fund.

Appropriates moneys for purposes of Ballot Measure 98 (2016).

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2017.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to moneys for Ballot Measure 98; creating new provisions; amending section 4, chapter 1,
3 Oregon Laws 2017; and declaring an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 4, chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2017 (Ballot Measure 98), is amended to read:

6 **Sec. 4.** The amounts appropriated, allocated or otherwise made available under section 2,
7 **chapter 1, Oregon Laws 2017, [of this 2016 Act]** and apportioned under section 3, **chapter 1,**
8 **Oregon Laws 2017 (Ballot Measure 98 (2016)), [of this 2016 Act]** shall be in addition to the total
9 amount the Legislative Assembly would otherwise appropriate, allocate or make available for a
10 biennium for funding kindergarten through grade 12 public education, **including any amounts in**
11 **the State School Fund.**

12 **SECTION 2.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-
13 **ated to the Department of Education, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the**
14 **General Fund, the amount of \$294,000,000, which shall be deposited in the High School Grad-**
15 **uation and College and Career Readiness Fund established by section 2, chapter 1, Oregon**
16 **Laws 2017 (Ballot Measure 98 (2016)).**

17 **SECTION 3.** This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
18 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect**
19 **July 1, 2017.**
