

# Senate Bill 112

Sponsored by Senator RILEY (at the request of Kristine Phillips Evertz) (Pre-session filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires carbon monoxide alarm in enclosed structure that has carbon monoxide source and is occupied and used as food service facility or for-profit business. Provides that requirement does not apply to residential structures.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to carbon monoxide alarms.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 455.**

5 **SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section:**

6 (a) "Carbon monoxide alarm" means a device that:

7 (A) Detects carbon monoxide;

8 (B) Produces a distinctive audible alert when carbon monoxide is detected;

9 (C) Conforms to State Fire Marshal rules;

10 (D) Is listed by Underwriters Laboratories or any other nationally recognized testing  
11 laboratory or an equivalent organization; and

12 (E) Operates as a distinct unit or as two or more single station units wired to operate  
13 in conjunction with each other.

14 (b) "Carbon monoxide source" means:

15 (A) A heater, fireplace, appliance or cooking source that uses coal, kerosene, petroleum  
16 products, wood or other fuels that emit carbon monoxide as a by-product of combustion; or

17 (B) An attached garage with an opening that communicates directly with a space having  
18 characteristics described in subsection (2)(a) or (b) of this section.

19 (2) A carbon monoxide alarm is required in an enclosed structure that has a carbon  
20 monoxide source and:

21 (a) Is licensed under ORS chapter 624 and identified under the structural specialty code  
22 as having a use and occupancy classification in Group A-2; or

23 (b) Is used in the operation of one or more for-profit businesses and is not identified in  
24 the structural specialty code as having a use and occupancy classification in Group R.

25 (3) A carbon monoxide alarm required by this section must be installed in accordance  
26 with the manufacturer's instructions and any applicable requirements of the state building  
27 code.

28 **SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2017 Act applies to enclosed structures that are con-  
29 structed, reconstructed, altered or repaired on or after the effective date of this 2017 Act.**
