

**SENATE AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 205**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 9 through 15 and insert:

2 “(b) Notwithstanding any requirements prescribed for issuance of a teaching license, a person
3 whose application for a teaching license is pending may teach in the public schools of this state for
4 90 calendar days after the date of submission of the application if:

5 “(A) The person is not ineligible for a teaching license following background checks conducted
6 by the commission, including a criminal records check as provided in ORS 181A.195 and a back-
7 ground check through an interstate clearinghouse of revoked and suspended licenses;

8 “(B) The school district has completed the review of the employment history of the person as
9 required by ORS 339.374; and

10 “(C) The person and the school district have complied with any other requirements established
11 by the commission by rule.”.
