

Senate Bill 218

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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Establishes Task Force on the Every Student Succeeds Act.
Sunsets task force on December 31, 2017.
Declares emergency, effective on passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to the Every Student Succeeds Act; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Task Force on the Every Student Succeeds Act is established.**

5 **(2) The task force consists of seven members appointed as follows:**

6 **(a) The President of the Senate shall appoint two members from among members of the**
7 **Senate, neither of whom may be from the same political party.**

8 **(b) The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint two members from among**
9 **members of the House of Representatives, neither of whom may be from the same political**
10 **party.**

11 **(c) The Superintendent of Public Instruction shall appoint three members.**

12 **(3) The task force shall:**

13 **(a) Review the Every Student Succeeds Act and state education law; and**

14 **(b) Recommend any legislation necessary to ensure that state law complies with the Ev-**
15 **ery Student Succeeds Act.**

16 **(4) A majority of the members of the task force constitutes a quorum for the transaction**
17 **of business.**

18 **(5) Official action by the task force requires the approval of a majority of the members**
19 **of the task force.**

20 **(6) The task force shall elect one of its members to serve as chairperson.**

21 **(7) If there is a vacancy for any cause, the appointing authority shall make an appoint-**
22 **ment to become immediately effective.**

23 **(8) The task force shall meet at times and places specified by the call of the chairperson**
24 **or of a majority of the members of the task force.**

25 **(9) The task force may adopt rules necessary for the operation of the task force.**

26 **(10) The task force shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and**
27 **may include recommendations for legislation, to an interim committee of the Legislative**
28 **Assembly related to education no later than September 15, 2017.**

29 **(11) The Department of Education shall provide staff support to the task force.**

30 **(12) Notwithstanding ORS 171.072, members of the task force who are members of the**

1 **Legislative Assembly are not entitled to mileage expenses or a per diem and serve as volun-**
2 **teers on the task force. Other members of the task force are not entitled to compensation**
3 **or reimbursement for expenses and serve as volunteers on the task force.**

4 **(13) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111, are directed to assist**
5 **the task force in the performance of the task force's duties and, to the extent permitted by**
6 **laws relating to confidentiality, to furnish information and advice the members of the task**
7 **force consider necessary to perform their duties.**

8 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2017 Act is repealed on December 31, 2017.**

9 **SECTION 3. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
10 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect**
11 **on its passage.**

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
