**SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Requires each post-secondary educational institution that provides housing for students to provide to each student enrolling or registering at institution for first time information on vaccine-preventable diseases known to occur in individuals between 16 and 21 years of age.

**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

Relating to immunizations; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 433.282.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 433.235 to 433.284.**

**SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section, "post-secondary institution of education" means:**

**(a) A public university listed in ORS 352.002;**

**(b) A community college operated under ORS chapter 341; or**

**(c) An Oregon-based, generally accredited, private institution of higher education.**

**(2) Each post-secondary institution of education that provides housing for students shall provide to each student enrolling or registering at the institution for the first time information on vaccine-preventable diseases known to occur in individuals between 16 and 21 years of age, including:**

**(a) The signs and symptoms associated with, and options for treating, vaccine-preventable diseases known to occur in individuals between 16 and 21 years of age;**

**(b) The circumstances that create a risk of acquiring a vaccine-preventable disease known to occur in individuals between 16 and 21 years of age, including the circumstance of living in group quarters;**

**(c) Recommendations by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention with respect to vaccines recommended to be categorized as category A or category B by the federal Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices, and vaccines recognized as category A or category B by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention;**

**(d) Any additional information on the availability, benefits and risks and limitations of vaccines for vaccine-preventable diseases known to occur in individuals between 16 and 21 years of age, as determined by the institution; and**

**(e) Information on where to receive a vaccination.**

**NOTE:** Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter *[italic and bracketed]* is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.

1       **(3) At a minimum, information provided under subsection (2) of this section must cover**  
2 **vaccine-preventable diseases for which the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention re-**  
3 **commend vaccination for individuals between 16 and 21 years of age.**

4       **(4) In developing information on vaccine-preventable diseases under this section, a post-**  
5 **secondary institution of education shall consult the Oregon Health Authority or the Centers**  
6 **for Disease Control and Prevention.**

7       **(5) If a post-secondary institution of education provides electronic enrollment or regis-**  
8 **tration for students enrolling or registering at the institution for the first time, the institu-**  
9 **tion shall provide the information required by this section electronically at the time of**  
10 **enrollment or registration.**

11       **(6) This section does not create a private right of action against a post-secondary insti-**  
12 **tution of education.**

13       **SECTION 3.** ORS 433.282 is amended to read:

14       433.282. (1) The Oregon Health Authority may require each post-secondary educational institu-  
15 tion, except a community college or a career school, to require, *[that]* **using procedures developed**  
16 **by the institution,** each *[entering]* full-time student *[has current immunizations,]* **to be immunized,**  
17 as required for children attending school pursuant to rules adopted by the authority under ORS  
18 433.273, *[prior to]* **before** the student's second quarter or semester of enrollment on *[an Oregon*  
19 *campus, using procedures developed by the institution.]* **the campus of the institution.**

20       (2) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, the authority may require each post-secondary  
21 educational institution, except a community college or a career school, to document, using proce-  
22 dures developed by the institution, that each *[entering]* full-time student *[has current*  
23 *immunizations,]* **has been immunized,** as required for children attending school pursuant to rules  
24 adopted by the authority under ORS 433.273, *[prior to]* **before** the student *[attending]* **attends** classes  
25 if the student will be attending the institution pursuant to a nonimmigrant visa.

26       (3) The authority by rule shall establish immunization schedules *[and may further]* **for purposes**  
27 **of this section.**

28       **(4) The authority by rule may limit the students and programs to which the** *[requirement ap-*  
29 *plies.]* **requirements of this section apply.**

30       *[(4)]* **(5) The authority may conduct validation surveys to ensure compliance with the require-**  
31 **ments of** this section.  
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
