

Senate Bill 280

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Appropriates moneys to Department of Education for purposes of developing academic content standards for Oregon Studies and preparing materials to support teacher training and classroom instruction in Oregon Studies.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2017.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to Oregon Studies; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Department of Education, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$_____, for the purposes of:

(1) Developing academic content standards for Oregon Studies in the manner described in ORS 329.492; and

(2) Supporting teacher training and classroom instruction in Oregon Studies in the manner described in ORS 329.492.

SECTION 2. This 2017 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2017 Act takes effect July 1, 2017.
