

# Senate Bill 289

Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Workforce)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Higher Education Coordinating Commission to develop website to match students with industry professionals for purposes of improving access to internships, job shadowing opportunities and work experience.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to a website for matching students with industry professionals.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Higher Education Coordinating Commission shall develop a website**  
5 **that may be used to match students in secondary and post-secondary educational institutions**  
6 **in Oregon with industry professionals for the purposes of improving access to internships,**  
7 **job shadowing opportunities and work experience.**

8 **(2) The commission may consult or collaborate with public or private organizations in**  
9 **developing the website.**

10 **(3) The commission may comply with this section by causing an existing website, whether**  
11 **or not owned or operated by the commission, to be modified to perform the functions de-**  
12 **scribed in subsection (1) of this section.**
