## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure as introduced.

Directs Higher Education Coordinating Commission to develop website to match students with industry professionals for purposes of improving access to internships, job shadowing opportunities and work experience.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to a website for matching students with industry professionals.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
  - SECTION 1. (1) The Higher Education Coordinating Commission shall develop a website that may be used to match students in secondary and post-secondary educational institutions in Oregon with industry professionals for the purposes of improving access to internships, job shadowing opportunities and work experience.
  - (2) The commission may consult or collaborate with public or private organizations in developing the website.
  - (3) The commission may comply with this section by causing an existing website, whether or not owned or operated by the commission, to be modified to perform the functions described in subsection (1) of this section.
