

# Senate Bill 335

Printed pursuant to Senate Interim Rule 213.28 by order of the President of the Senate in conformance with pre-session filing rules, indicating neither advocacy nor opposition on the part of the President (at the request of Senate Interim Committee on Business and Transportation)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Department of Transportation to study ways to increase amount of funding received by counties with fewer than 200,000 registered vehicles.  
Sunsets January 2, 2020.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to transportation.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Transportation shall study ways to increase the**  
5 **amount of funding received by counties with fewer than 200,000 registered vehicles. The de-**  
6 **partment shall make a report on its findings.**

7 **(2) The department shall submit the report required by subsection (1) of this section, and**  
8 **may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative**  
9 **Assembly related to transportation in the manner provided under ORS 192.245 no later than**  
10 **September 15, 2019.**

11 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2017 Act is repealed on January 2, 2020.**
