## Senate Bill 336

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Allows construction contractor or business to temporarily continue operation after person ceases to be responsible managing individual for contractor or business.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to responsible managing individuals.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
  - SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2017 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 701.
  - SECTION 2. (1) Notwithstanding ORS 701.081, 701.084 and 701.091, if a person ceases to be the responsible managing individual for a contractor or business that is required under this chapter to have a responsible managing individual, the contractor or business may temporarily operate without a responsible managing individual.
  - (2) The contractor or business must send written notice to the Construction Contractors Board no later than three business days after the contractor or business ceases to have a responsible managing individual. The notice must contain the name of the former responsible managing individual, the date the person ceased to be the responsible managing individual for the contractor or business and any other information required by the board. The board shall inform the contractor or business of the date by which the board must receive written notice identifying a new responsible managing individual for the contractor or business.
  - (3) The board shall adopt rules establishing the maximum period that a contractor or business described in this section may operate without having a responsible managing individual.
  - SECTION 3. The Construction Contractors Board shall adopt temporary rules under section 2 of this 2017 Act to become effective no later than 90 days after the effective date of this 2017 Act. Section 2 of this 2017 Act applies when a person ceases to be the responsible managing individual for a construction contractor or business on or after the effective date of temporary rules adopted under section 2 of this 2017 Act.
